Call for Presentation Abstracts

The Oregon Stroke Network (OSN) is seeking abstracts for poster and/or oral presentations for the 14th Annual Oregon Stroke Conference to be held on October 16, 2020 via Zoom.

If you have never done a poster presentation, this is the perfect environment to venture out. The Planning Committee is here to support you and offer guidance. The Planning Committee has a goal to have a poster presentation from each represented organization.

Two Types of Presentations to Consider

- 1) **Oral Presentation:** Oral presentations should showcase stroke related project, process improvement, or research that would be of interest to a large audience. This presentation **should not** have been presented to OSN audience previously; however, former presentation outside of Oregon would be acceptable. Oral presentations will be approximately 20 minutes in length.
- 2) **Poster Display:** The poster should be on stroke related project, research, or process improvement. This poster **should not** have been presented to OSN audience previously; however, former presentation outside of Oregon would be acceptable

All abstract submissions will be reviewed and selected by the Conference Planning Committee.

We look forward to the generation of some great sharing of ideas and stroke work being done in Oregon.

Items needed to complete online submission form:

- Abstract document – 500 words or less
- Oral Presentations:
 - Bio for each presenter (one paragraph per presenter)
 - 3 objectives

Further Information:

- Notification of acceptance will be sent by September 20th, via email &/or phone. Authors/presenters must confirm participation in the symposium within 48 hours.
- All accepted abstracts will be published on the OSN website prior to the conference. Abstract title and author(s) will be listed.
- PDF version of Poster to be provided by Oct. 5th.
- Symposium registration fees will be waived for primary presenter of oral abstract.
 - If registration fee has already been paid, a refund will be processed.
- Instructions for oral abstract presentation will be sent with acceptance notice.
